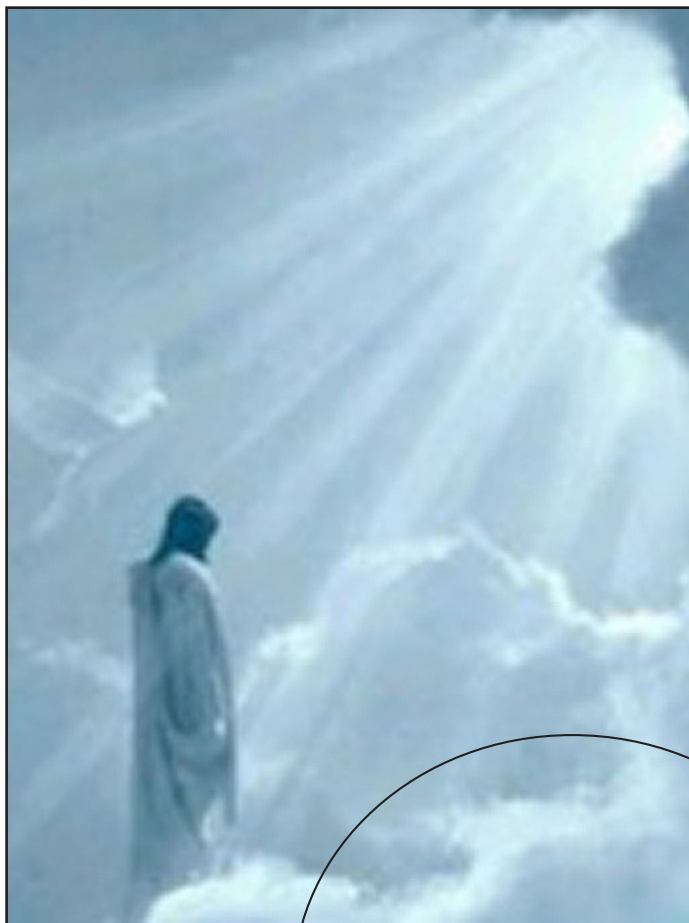

SCRIPTURE

Deuteronomy 6:4-9
