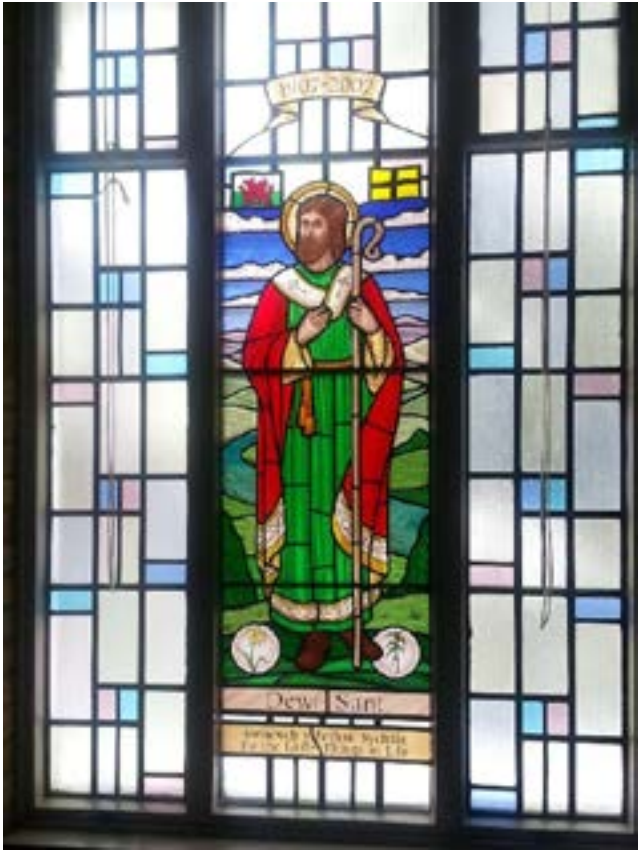

TODAY'S GUEST PREACHER: REV. DR. ORVILLE JAMES



Born in Ottawa, Orville grew up in a family steeped in Methodism. His father was a pastor, and two uncles were Wesleyan and Free Methodist pastors. Orville was educated at Queen's and Princeton, and ordained in 1978. He has served churches in New Brunswick, Ontario, and a Methodist Church in Maine. He has also done two 'exchanges' with the British

Methodist Church, serving congregations in the Rhondda Valley, near Pontypridd, Wales, and also near Tenterden, in Kent. While in Wales he explored the history of prayer revivals led by Rees Howell. The humility and devotional fervour of Welsh coal-mining communities has been an ongoing inspiration in Orville's ministry. Orville now considers himself a 'free agent for Jesus', and is enjoying supporting the next generation of ministers, and playing with six grandchildren spread from Vancouver to London, U.K.
