## **GUEST PREACHER: DAYLE K. BARRETT**



Dayle joined the clergy team at TEMC last summer. He is originally from London, England, where he was the twice-elected Member of Youth Parliament for Bexley, winning the Worshipful Company of the Glazier's Award for Community Service. Dayle has served as a Sunday School Teacher, Worship Leader, and Youth Pastor in the New Testament Church of God. He has also been involved in church planting and outreach ministry and was ordained

into the Tabernacle of Refuge in 2016. Now, he is a candidate for ordination in the United Church of Canada, where he has offered spiritual leadership since 2019.

Dayle holds a BTEC First Diploma in Public Services from the Cadet Vocational Qualifications Organization and a Master of Divinity from Emmanuel College. At convocation, he was awarded the 2024 Sanford Gold Medal in Divinity – their highest honor for “scholarship, ability, and character.” He is passionate about proclaiming the gospel, making disciples, and building faithful community. As a scholar, however, his main interests are in biblical theology, which he hopes to pursue at the doctorate level.




**TORONTO WELSH MALE VOICE CHOIR


