A UNESCO-backed initiative unique to Wales, the Peace and Goodwill Message has been produced by the children of Wales since 1922, continuing to be sent even during periods of war and global turmoil. Previous subjects have ranged from atomic weapons to climate change, while last year's message focused on poverty. The message has also taken on a number of forms, initially being broadcast via morse code, before moving to radio, and is now posted online, both in written form and in a short video format.

When a bombshell letter from an inmate at the notorious Mercer Women's Prison lands on Emily's desk, she sees the scoop of a lifetime—one that could launch her career as a journalist. But after going undercover to investigate the inmate's shocking claims, Emily discovers that getting into the prison is the easy part; the real challenge will be getting back out... Huron County, 1996: Unidentified female remains are discovered in an unmarked grave in a small-town Ontario cemetery, and Detective Rachel Mackenzie is tasked with unraveling the mystery. But when the investigation leads her to the now-shuttered Mercer Women's Prison, the family trauma she's kept buried for years threatens to surface.
