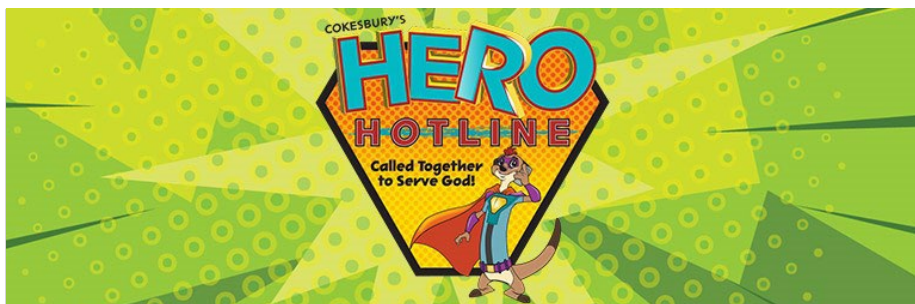
Mondays at 10:00 am and Wednesdays at 5:30 pm.
