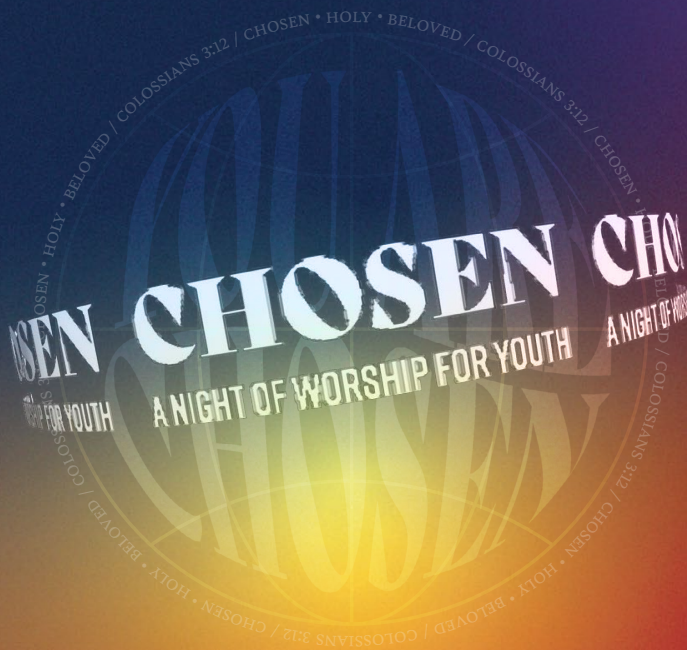

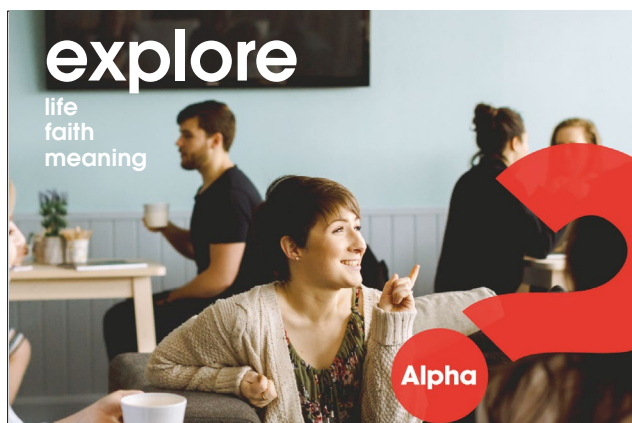
YOUTH ALPHA SERIES: WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 4 AT 6:30 PM

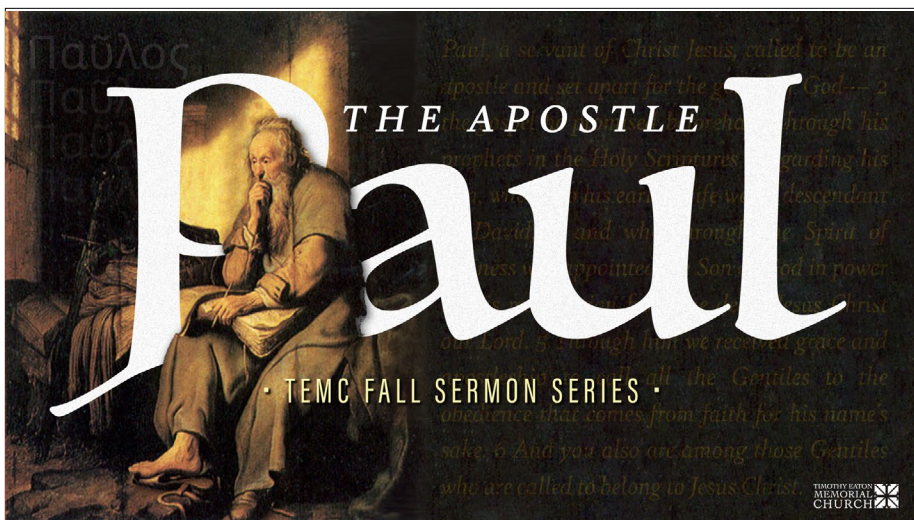


ALPHA SERIES OCTOBER 4: Wednesdays at 7:00PM
