Please Read Carefully!

1. Participation in the pageants is open to everyone, subject to casting requirements.
2. Attendance at both pageants and all specified rehearsals is necessary. (See attached rehearsal schedule.)
3. Roles will be assigned based on casting and script requirements and costume availability. (Some roles may require auditions.)
4. Please leave your completed registration form in the Volunteer Office in the mailbox for Joanne Leatch.

Adults and teens in the pageant fill a wide variety of cast and crew roles and responsibilities, such as:

- A) Bethlehem townspeople (in costume), census-takers, "tax" collectors, market-place sellers, animal guides, etc.
- B) Story characters (in costume), including Mary & Joseph, angels, Roman centurions, shepherds, Magi, pages, etc.
- C) Crew (street dress), including assistant directors and stagehands, costume helpers, church cleaner-uppers (after each performance), greeters, child minders, etc.

Children in the pageant (in costume) are Bethlehem townspeople such as bread sellers, angels, shepherds, junior centurions, pages, etc.

Please note that, in order to ensure the safety of all pageant participants, attendance at all rehearsals is **mandatory**. If you have any issues with the schedule, please be in touch with Pageant Director Andrew Adridge.
