TEMC is able to reach people beyond the walls of the church through our live streaming capabilities. We are able to broadcast Sunday services, special events, and concerts to a broad audience. Currently, we average approximately 500 weekly viewers through the live stream. We are blessed to be able to share the good news of Jesus and build community online.

## Roles

There are different roles that are responsible for making the broadcast possible.

- Camera Operator
  - This role is responsible for capturing the visuals of a service or event using various camera angles. Currently, we have three cameras placed in non-intrusive locations in the sanctuary to capture all the activity that happens during an event.
  - The operator uses a controller and switcher to set up shots and switch between scenes throughout an event.
  - Experience is an asset but not required. We'd be glad to train you!

## Sound Mixer

- This role is responsible for balancing the audio during services, concerts or other events such as the Christmas Pageant.
- There is a mixer in the sanctuary responsible for balancing the audio for in-person audiences; There is also a mixer in the radio room that balances the sound for the radio and online livestream.
- Experience is recommended, but can be trained.
- ProPresenter (Graphics/Text Operator)
  - This role is responsible for creating and displaying the graphics and text that appears on the livestream. These overlays help the online audience follow along with songs, scripture, and the sermon. We use ProPresenter software to create the various overlays.
  - Experience is an asset but not required. We'd be glad to train you!
