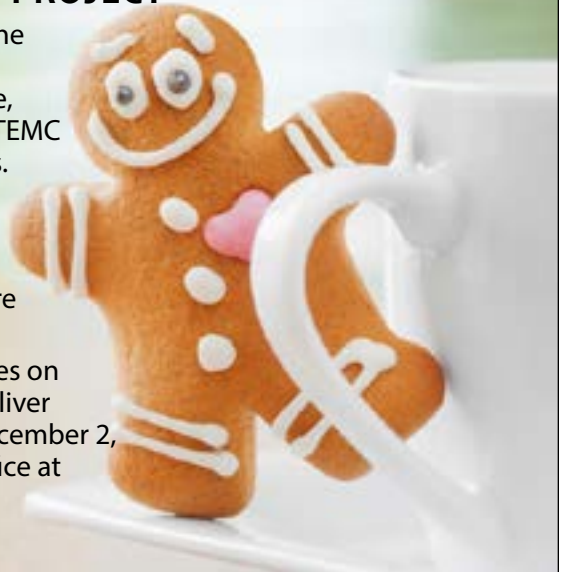


## **CHRISTMAS COOKIE PROJECT**

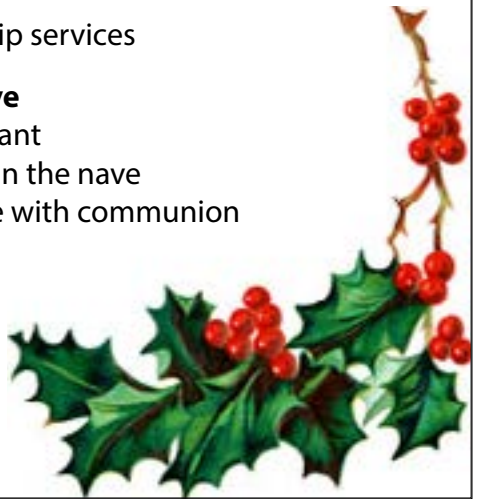
